Complete kit. Verify all components are present prior to beginning installation.



Complete stock intake.



Remove the phillips screws on the side of the air box lid.(1&2). Remove the MAF from the air box by removing the two phillips screws (3&4)



Disconnect the smog pump from the air box lid.



Remove the factory air box lid and air filter.



Remove the two 10mm bolts securing the lower portion of the air box. Remove the air box.



Lower the housing assembly in the engine compartment. Secure the MAF sensor to the housing with the sunnied hardware



Connect the elbow to the smog pump inlet hose. Secure with the supplied mini clamp. Slide the elbow thru the opening on the side of the housing.




Slide the intake breather air filter over the smog pump elbow. Secure with the provided clamp.



Secure the housing to the engine compartment with the supplied hardware.



Install the intake tube, couplers and air filter. Do not use any grease or oil.



If you are installing the intake system on a 1.9L TDI. Connect the vacuum hose to the intake nipple. On vehicles not equipped with a vacuum line. Use the supplied vacuum nipple.



Place enclosed CARB EO sticker on a clean/smooth surface on or near the intake system. EO identification label is required in passing the Smog Check inspection. Your installation is now complete. Tighten all connections and clamps. Re-check after a few hours.
