Step		Description					illustration						
1 Identify the grille & hardware with parts list.													
2		Start with main grille section. Pop hood, remove the black plastic cover (on top of OEM grille / front panel) from vehicle. This will allow access to the rear of the grille shell.											
3		Thread a screw in each nut welded to the grille. From the rear, place a tab on each screw. Now thread a nut and a washer on each screw.											
4	Center the grille into the opening of the factory grille shell. Secure the bolt to the threaded holes on the front of the grille.Be sure the bolts are through the OEM grille shell.												
5	Secu	Secure grille using the nuts and washes from the back side of the OEM grille shell.											
6	Conti	Continue to the bumper grille section. Remove the plastic filler panel from each of the two bumper opening.											
7	Cente	Center the wire mesh grilles into each of the bumper openings.											
8		Place the short stainless J-brackets over the fully threaded studs at the top of the wire mesh grille and hook the other end over the lip on the backside of the bumper opening and hold in place using the nylon nuts.											
9		Place the long stainless J-brackets over the fully threaded studs at the bottom of the wire mesh grille and hook the other side over the lip on the backside of the bumper opening and hold in place using the nylon nuts.											
10	Make	sure the grille is centered ar	nd tighte	en the fasten	ers, b	ut do no	t over-tighten.						
11	Reins	stall the black plastic cover w	hich wa	s removed ir	n step	2.							
12	Instal	Installation completed!!!
