Install Notes: Overlay Replacement Drill Cut Step **Description** illustration Identify the grille & hardware with parts list. N/A 1 Pop hood, remove the black plastic cover (on top of OEM grille / front panel) from vehicle. This will allow access to the rear 2 of the grille shell. The first step of the installation is to take the billet grille and insert it into the plastic section of the bumper. Next take a drill 3 and drill through the 2 small brackets (Fig 1) with holes in them on the back side of the billet and through the black plastic of the bumper. (Fig 2) Insert a #8 screw through the small bracket with the hole in it and through the black plastic section of the bumper. From 4 behind the bumper install a flat nut on the back side of the screw and tighten with a phillips screwdriver. (Fig 3) Repeat this on the other small bracket that is welded on the backside of the billet. 5 Make sure the billet grille is centered and tighten the fasteners.but do not over-tighten. 6 Reinstall the black plastic cover which was removed in step 2. 7 Installation completed!!!







The instruction here is for your reference only. You may need to bend the billet grille bars or tabs a little bit to adjust to fit. We strongly recommend the professional installer for best result.

Please use masking tape and tape the OEM grille shell along the edge to protect your vehicle during installation.
