



1	Identify the grille and hardware with parts list.

Remove license plate from the bumper. (Fig 1&2)

3	Attach U-Clips on the two-hole tab, one at each hole, make sure the small hole on the clip is pointing at the opposite direction from the tab bending angle. (Fig 3)

4	Put two-hole tab on the back of the grille and align with the welded tab. Thread in screws for the top section first to secure two-hole tabs on the welded tabs. (Fig 4)

5	Hold the billet insert up to the opening of the factory shell, and make sure that it is centered. Rotate the two-hole tab and make sure it clamps the back of the OEM grille shell. Then, thread in two more screws on the bottom section to secure the two-hole tabs on the welded tabs. Tighten the screws, but not over tighten.		
7	Installation completed.
