

INSULATION INSTRUCTION:

REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION.

- 1. From the driver side of vehicle, locate the two factory holes above the front, center and rear rubber grommets in the side panel (**Figure 1**).
- 2. Starting from the front, insert the short end of one of the M8 U-Bolts into one of the factory holes and out from the opposite hole (**Figur2**).
- 3. Attach the driver side front Mounting Bracket with the previously inserted M8 U- Bolt. NOTE: Hold the U-Bolt in place and line up the threaded ends with the slots in the Mounting Bracket. Do not let the U-Bolt fall into the body panel. Secure Mounting Bracket to U-Bolt using (2) M8 Lock Washer, (2) M8 flat Washers and (2) M8 hex nuts, (Figure 3). Finger tighten.
- **4.** Position one of the clamp Plates over pinch weld and Mounting Bracket. **NOTE:** Mount the clamp plate with the concave facing the inside of the vehicle, (**Figure 4**). Partially attach the clamp plate to the Mounting Bracket using the included(2) M8x40mm Hex Bolts, (2)M8 Lock Washers, (4)M8 Flat Washers and (2) M8 Hex Nuts, (**Figure 5-7**). Finger tighten.
- **5.** Repeat steps 3-4 for rear and center Mounting Bracket installation (**Figure 5-7**).

- **6.** Select the Running Board. Slip (6) 6mm T-Bolts into each bottom channel (Figure 8). Carefully position the Running Board onto the (3) Mounting Brackets. Attach the Running Board to the Mounting Brackets with (6) 6mm T-bolts,(6)6mm flat washers and (6)6mm lock nuts, (Figure 9). Do not tighten hardware.
- **7.** Adjust the Side bar properly and tighten all hardware at this time.
- **8.** Repeat steps 2-7 for passenger Sidebar installation.
- **9.** Do periodic inspections of the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

To protect your investment, wax this product after installing. Regular waxing is recommended to add a protective layer over the finish. Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish. **For Polished Finishes**: Aluminum polish may be used to polish small scratches and scuffs on the finish. Mild soap may

be used also to clean the Running Board.

For black finishes: Mild soap may be used to clean the Running Board.
