

## PROCEDURE: REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ ISTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION.

- Locate the driver Front Upper Bracket with the factory bolt. Then, select the Driver Front Lower Mounting Bracket, bolt to the front upper bracket with (2)10mmx35 Hex bolts,(4)10mm flat washers,(2)10mm lock washers and (2)10mm Hex nuts. (Fig. 1). Do not tighten at this time.
- 2. Locate the driver rear upper Bracket with the factory bolt. Then, select the driver rear lower mounting bracket, bolt to the rear upper bracket with (2)10mmx35 Hex bolts,(4)10mm flat washers,(2)10mm lock washers and (2)10mm Hex nuts. (Fig. 2). Do not tighten at this time.
- 3. Select a Running Board. Slip(12)6mm T-bolts into each bottom channel(Fig. 3). Carefully position the Running Board onto the (2) Mounting Brackets. IMPORTANT: Do not slide, (front to back), the Running Board on the Brackets or damage to the finish may result. Attach the Running Board to the Front Mounting Brackets with(6) 6mm T-bolts,(6)6mm flat washers and (6)6mm lock nuts (Fig. 4), Do not tighten at this time.
- **4.** Level and adjust the Running Board and tighten all hardware.
- **5.** Repeat **Steps 1 4** for Passenger Running Board installation.

**6.** Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

**To protect your investment**, wax this product after installing. Regular waxing is recommended to add a protective layer over the finish. Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish.

**For Polished Finishes**: Aluminum polish may be used to polish small scratches and scuffs on the finish. Mild soap may be used also to clean the Running Board.

For Black Finishes: Mild soap may be used to clean the Running Board.
