Installation Instructions for IB06EAG7

PROCEDURE:

- 1. REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION.


(Fig 2) Slide 8mm Clip Nuts over holes

- 2. Starting on the driver side of the vehicle, locate the (2) holes in the bottom of the body panel, (pinch weld), toward the front tire, (Figure 1). Next locate the rectangular opening and (2) small holes in the inner body panel directly above the holes in the pinch weld, (Figures 1 & 2). NOTE: The holes in the inner panel may be covered with sealing tape or insulation.
- 3. Slide (1) 8mm Clip Nut into the rectangular opening with the nut towards the inside. Line up the threaded nut on the clip with the round hole, (**Figure 2**). Repeat to install the 2nd 8mm Clip Nut in remaining hole location.




(Fig 4) Driver/left front mounting Bracket

- **4.** Select the front Bracket, Attach the Bracket to the (2) Clip Nuts with the included (2) M8 x 30 Hex Bolts, (2) M8 Lock Washers and (2)M8 Large Flat Washers, (Figures 3 & 4). Depending on model and year, the brake cable may be run on the inside or outside of the Bracket. Do not tighten hardware at this time. **NOTE:** The cradle on the front Bracket should face to the rear of the vehicle.
- **5.** Align the bottom holes in the front Bracket with the (2) holes in the pinch weld. Bolt the Bracket to the pinch weld using the included (2) M8 x 25mm Hex Bolts, (4) M8 Flat Washers, (2) M8 Lock Washers and (2) M8 Hex Nuts, **(Figures 3 & 4)**. **NOTE:** Insert the bolts up from the bottom of the pinch weld and through the Bracket.




(Fig 5) Driver/left center mounting location pictured

- 6. Next, move toward the center of the vehicle. Locate the (2) holes in the pinch weld similar to the front location, Insert (1) 8mm Clip Nut into the rectangular opening and up to the single small round hole in the body panel, (Figure 5).
- 7. Select the driver side center Mounting Bracket. (Figure 6). Attach the Bracket to the Clip Nut with (1) M8 x 30mm Hex Bolt, (1) M8 Lock Washer and (1) M8 Large Flat Washer, (Figures 7 & 8). Line up the hole in the Bracket with the hole in the pinch weld. Bolt the Bracket to the pinch weld with (1) M8 x 25mm Hex Bolt, (2) M8 Flat Washers, (1) M8 Lock Washer and (1) M8 Hex Nut. Do not tighten


- hardware at this time. **NOTE:** The cradle on the center mounting Bracket will face the front of the vehicle.
- 8. Continue along the cab to the rear mounting location. Locate the last (2) mounting holes in the pinch weld towards the back of the cab, (Figures 1). Repeat Steps 2—5 for rear mounting Bracket installation. NOTE: The cradle on the rear Bracket should face the front of the vehicle.
- **9.** Select a Running Board. Slip(10) M6 T-bolts into each bottom channel(**Figure 9**). Carefully position the Running Board onto the (3) Mounting Brackets. **IMPORTANT**: Do not slide, (front to back), the Running Board on the Brackets or damage to the finish may result. Attach the Running Board to the Front & Rear Mounting Brackets with(4) M6 T-bolts,(4)M6 flat washers and (4)M6 nylon lock nuts (**Figures 10**). Attach the Running Board to the Center Mounting Brackets with(2) M6 T-bolts,(2)M6 flat washers and (2)M6 nylon lock nuts. Do not tighten at this time.
- **10.** Level and adjust the Running Board and fully tighten all hardware.
- 11. Repeat Steps 2—10 for passenger Running Board installation.
- **12.** Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.


To protect your investment, wax this product after installing. Regular waxing is recommended to add a protective layer over the finish. Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish.

For Polished Finishes: Aluminum polish may be used to polish small scratches and scuffs on the finish. Mild soap may be used also to clean the Running Board.

For Black Finishes: Mild soap may be used to clean the Running Board.





(Fig 3) Driver/left front mounting Bracket



(Fig 6) Driver/left center Bracket


