

PROCEDURE:


- 1. REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION.
- 2. Start installation at the front of the driver side of the vehicle and locate the factory threaded holes or stud located on the side of the inner body panel, (Figure 1). NOTE: Remove the plastic plug or any insulation on the side panel to locate the threaded holes.


(Fig 2) Driver/left Bracket illustrated for example only

- 3. Select (1) Mounting Bracket. Attach the Bracket to the mounting location thread stud with (1) 8mm x 24mm Flat Washer (1)8mm Lock Washer and (1) 8mm Hex Nut. Next, insert (1) 8mm x 35mm Hex Bolt with (1) 8mm Lock Washer and (1) 8mm x 24mm Flat Washer through the remaining lower hole in the Bracket and into the threaded hole, **(Figures 1, 2 and 3)**. Do not tighten hardware at this time.
- 4. Repeat the appropriate Steps 2—3 to install rear Mounting Brackets. NOTE: All the brackets are universal.
- 5. Once all two Mounting Brackets are partially installed, Select the Running Board. Slip (8) 6mm T-Bolts into each bottom channel (Figure 4). Carefully position the Running Board onto the Mounting Brackets. Attach the Running Board to the Mounting Brackets with (4) 6mm T-bolts, (4) 6mm flat washers and (4) 6mm lock nuts, (Figure 5). Do not tighten hardware at this time.
- **6.** Level and adjust the Running Board and tighten all hardware at this time.
- 7. Repeat **Steps 2—6** for passenger Running Board installation.
- 8. Do periodic inspections of the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.


To protect your investment, wax this product after installing. Regular waxing is recommended to add a protective layer over the finish. Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish.

For Polished Finishes: Aluminum polish may be used to polish small scratches and scuffs on the finish. Mild soap may be used also to clean the Running Board.


For Black Finishes: Mild soap may be used to clean the Running Board.

Driver Side Installation Pictured
