

### **Notes and Maintenance**

Before you begin installation, read all instructions thoroughly.

Proper tools will improve the quality of installation and reduce the time required.

To protect the product, wax after installing. Regular waxing is recommended to add a protective layer over the finish. Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish.

For polished, gloss and other smooth finishes,

polish may be used to clear small scratches and scuffs on the finish.

Mild automotive detergent may be used to clean the product. Do not use dish detergent, abrasive cleaners, abrasive pads, wire brushes or other similar products that may damage the finish.

Refer to the last page of this manual for product registration information.

Refer to the table below when securing hardware during the installation process to help prevent damage to the product or vehicle.

### Step 1

Starting on the driver side, locate the three mounting locations underneath the vehicle.

**Note:** Each bracket is specific to a mounting location. Reference to the product image on page 1 for correct locations.




### Step 2

Locate the front mounting points.

Insert an M10 T-bolt plate into the side opening and an M10 x 25.4mm T-bolt plate into the rear opening. Slide a plastic bolt retainer over the threads of the bolts to secure the bolts in place.





### Step 3

Place the front driver-side bracket onto the vehicle and secure with two M10 hex nuts, lock washers and flat washers.

Snug the hardware, but do not fully tighten.





### Step 4

Locate the middle mounting points.

Insert an M10 T-bolt plate into side opening. Slide a plastic bolt retainer over the threads of the bolt to secure the bolt in place.

Fishwire an M6 carriage bolt and spacer plate into the mounting location.





### Step 5

Place the middle driver-side bracket onto the vehicle and secure with an M10 hex nut, lock washer and flat washer.

With an M6 carriage bolt in place, secure with an M6 hext nut, lock washer and flat washer.

Snug the hardware, but do not fully tighten.



### Step 6

Locate the rear mounting points and remove the rubber plugs.

Insert an M8 nut plate into the side opening.

In the second mounting location, fishwire a 1/2" carriage bolt and spacer plate into place.






### Step 7

Place the rear driver-side bracket onto the vehicle and secure the nut plate with an M8 hex bolt, lock washer and flat washer.

With a 1/2" carriage bolt in place, secure with a 1/2" hex nut, lock washer and flat washer.

Snug the hardware, but do not fully tighten.



### Step 8

Remove the M8 nuts, lock washers and flat washers from the running board.

Place the running board onto the brackets and align the M8 bolts with the slots in the brackets on the vehicle.





### Step 9

Attach the running board to the brackets using six M8 bolts, lock washers, flat washers and nuts.

Snug the hardware, but do not fully tighten.





### Step 10

Adjust and level the running board, centering it between the front and rear wheel wells.

With the running board in position, it is recommended to tighten all brackets to the vehicle first, followed by the running board connections.





### Step 11

Repeat steps 1 through 10 on the passenger side of the vehicle.

Congratulations on the installation of your new ARIES AeroTread  $^{\text{\tiny TM}}$  running boards.

With the running boards installed, periodic inspections should be performed to ensure all mounting hardware remains tight.
