Do not allow dirt or grease to enter the system. Always wear standard hand, ear, and eye protection when servicing the air suspension system.

### **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

- Not to be stored below 5°F (-15°C) or above 122°F (50°C).
- Avoid damage to air lines and cables.
- Removal and installation is only to be performed by fully qualified personnel.
- Use car manufacturer's diagnostic software.

**CAUTION**: Damage to the vehicle and air suspension system can be incurred if work is carried out in a manner other than specified in the instructions or in a different sequence.



To avoid the possibility of short circuits while working with electric components consult your owner's manual on how to disconnect your battery.

Under no circumstances should any work be completed underneath the vehicle if it is not adequately supported, as serious injuries and death can occur.

### **AIR STRUT REMOVAL**

- SET STEERING TO STRAIGHT AHEAD.
- RAISE THE VEHICLE.
- 3. REMOVE REAR WHEEL.
- 4. REMOVE THE SIDE COVER OF THE REAR DASH PANELTO EXPOSE THE TOP OF THE AIR SHOCK (LOCATED IN THE REAR WINDOW AREA). (FIGURE A)






