

## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS Jeep Dash Pod Installation

For 2018+ Jeep JL Wrangler



Designed for rectangular rocker switches (\*Not included) that fit 0.96" x 1.9" cutouts and Mini CBs (\*Not included) that are no wider than 4.5" x 1.75"

- 1. Disconnect the Negative battery cable.
- 2. Remove the rubber tray liner.
- 3. Pre-wire the switches. Tip: Using a small piece of masking tape to label the wires will help make it easier to finish the wiring later.
- 4. Make sure that the rubber gasket included with most switches is installed; this will help keep the switches from rattling.
- 5. Run the wires through the corresponding openings and push the switches in until they "click" in place.
- 6. Attach 2 pieces of the included 3M™ Dual-Lock™ to the top of CB by pushing firmly in a location that will best secure the CB. Tip: cleaning the surface that the 3M™ Dual-Lock™ will be adhered to with alcohol beforehand and letting it dry will help adhesion.
- 7. Click in a piece of 3M™ Dual-Lock™ into each of the 2 previously installed pieces, making sure they are fully seated.
- 8. Remove the backing tape from these 2 pieces of 3M™ Dual-Lock™ and carefully slide the CB into the large rectangular cutout, then position the CB were desired. Then place the pod on a flat surface and push firmly on the bottom of the CB to adhere. Tip: it might be easier to insert the CB from the bottom and push CB through the cutout from back if the height of the 3M™ Dual-Lock™ pieces interfere.
- 9. Attach wires and antenna to the CB and route the switch wires to your desired location.
- 10. Insert the bottom making sure the "grill" portion is under the CB. The "grill" allows CBs that have a bottom firing speaker to still be heard.
- 11. Attach a piece of the included 3M<sup>™</sup> Dual-Lock<sup>™</sup> to the underneath of the cubby, make sure to push firmly.
- 12. Click in a piece of 3M<sup>™</sup> Dual-Lock<sup>™</sup> into the installed piece, making sure it is fully seated. Tip: cleaning the surface that 3M<sup>™</sup> Dual-Lock<sup>™</sup> will be adhered to with alcohol beforehand and letting it dry will help adhesion.
- 13. Make sure the bottom of the dash tray has been cleared of debris and cleaned with alcohol.
- 14. Remove the backing tape from these 2 pieces of 3M<sup>™</sup> Dual-Lock<sup>™</sup> and carefully slide the entire pod into the dash trays large rectangular section. Make sure to push the bottom of the cubby firmly to best adhere the 3M<sup>™</sup> Dual-Lock<sup>™</sup>.
- 15. Finish wiring the switches and CB per the instruction included by their manufacturer.
- 16. Reconnect the Negative battery cable.
