

BDS Suspension Co. recommends this system be installed by a professional technician. In addition to these instructions, professional knowledge of disassembly/ reassembly procedures and post installation checks must be known.

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Park vehicle on clean level surface with wheels facing straight ahead. Block rear wheels for safety.
- 2. Remove OE stabilizer and discard hardware.
- 3. Cutoff passenger's side OE stabilizer mount as shown (Fig 1- front, Fig 2 back).

FIG 1 - FRONT







FIG 2 - BACK

- 4. Install studs into driver's and passenger's side brackets with lock washer and nut as shown in Figure 4. Torque to 65 ft-lbs.
- 5. Clamp passenger's side bracket (#01526) on lower control arm mount. Ensure that edges of the bracket are aligned with OE brackets. (Fig 3 & 4) Note: The top hole in the bracket will be offset to the outside of the vehicle.
- 6. Mark hole centers and drill two $\frac{1}{2}$ " holes in the OE bracket.
- 7. Install $\frac{1}{2}$ x 1-1/4" bolts, washers, and nuts from bolt pack #317 and torque to 75 ft-lbs.
- 8. Repeat steps 4-6 for driver's side bracket (#01525).
- 9. Loosely install center bracket (#01527) as shown in Figure 5. Use the larger diameter USS washers on the 1/2" x 2-1/2" bolt. A 1/2" USS washer is required between the center bracket and drag link. Install the 5/16" U-bolts with washers and nuts at this time.
- 10. Lightly grease bushings and install into both ends of stabilizers.







- 11. Install sleeve (#51792-1) into end of stabilizer that will connect to center mounting bracket.
- 12. Attach passenger's side stabilizer mounting bracket with included hardware. Torque to 55 ft-lbs. Repeat for driver's side.
- 13. Install stabilizers into center bracket with 1/2" x 2-1/2" bolts, washers, and nuts. Torque to 75 ft-lbs. (Fig 5)
- 14. Check all hardware for proper torque.
- 15. Check hardware after 500 miles.
