## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Raise vehicle and support the frame with jack stands.
- 2. Remove the skidpan.
- 3. Install the supplied bracket using the 5/16"x1-1/4"x2" u-bolts nuts and washers supplied. Do not tighten at this time.
- Install the supplied hourglass bushings and sleeves into the cylinder eyes with a bench vice, c-clamp or equivalent.
- 5. Attach the body end of the shock to the O.E. mounting bracket with O.E. hardware. Turn the steering wheel full left till it stops. Extend the shock 1/8".

- 6. Install the rod end into the steering linkage bracket and double check that the wheel is turned full left and shock is out 1/8". Torque u-bolts on linkage bracket to 15ft-lbs.
- 7. Perform a complete steering sweep to make sure that there is no interference. Reinstall skidpan.
