

## BEDRUG, Inc. BEDRUG® BEDLINER INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS SUPPLEMENT FOR INSTALLATION OVER SPRAY ON BEDLINER

## WARNING: IMPROPER INSTALLATION WILL RESULT IN LINER FLYING OUT OF THE TRUCK! FOLLOW INSTRUCTIONS EXACTLY!

- 1. This instruction guide is to be used in conjunction with the instruction sheet included with the BedRug.
- 2. Follow the installation sequence as instructed on the instruction sheet included with the BedRug.
- 3. Scuff the spray in liner areas where the hook fasteners are to be attached using steel wool or sandpaper. This must be done to provide a very rough surface for the adhesive to adhere to.
- 4. Using a cloth, soap and water, clean and dry this area thoroughly removing all dirt and debris. With a separate cloth, clean the area again with alcohol. After cleaning all surfaces with alcohol, apply the adhesive promoters included in this kit to a lint free cloth then apply a thin layer to all areas where the hook fasteners are to be attached. Be sure to allow the adhesive promoter to dry completely before adhering hook fasteners. \*See adhesive promoter information on the promoter package.
  - **Note:** Attach hook fasteners immediately after the adhesive promoter has evaporated completely.
- 5. The fourteen (14), 1"x2" hook fasteners included in this kit are to be used in place of the long (60"+) continuous hook fasteners in the installation kit included with the BedRug.
- 6. Use 5-7 pieces of these 1"x2" hook fasteners in place of the long hook fasteners on the top edge of the bulkhead panel and the tailgate panel.

**Note:** The long strips of hook fastener will not adhere properly to the spray on bedliner surface.
