Vehicle Application: Ford F-150 2015-Current 6.5' Bed Part Number 77336

Installation Tips

Before you begin installing your new Supertop for Trucks, please read all the instructions thoroughly.

It is recommended that two people install this Bestop product.

For a smooth fit:

For easier installation, the top should be installed at a temperature above 72° F. Below this temperature, the fabric may contract an inch or more, making it difficult to fit the vehicle. You may let the fabric sit in the sun for 15-20 minutes before installing to let the fabric warm up.

It is normal for the fabric to contract and wrinkle when stored in the shipping carton. Within a few days after installation, the fabric will relax and the wrinkles will disappear.

WARNING Do not rely in any way on the components of this product to protect against injury or death in the event of an accident. Never operate the vehicle in excess of manufacturer's specifications.

Read and follow, precisely, all installation instructions provided when installing this product. Failure to do so may result in a poor fit and could place occupants of the vehicle in a potentially dangerous situation.










Parts List

- Required parts for installation





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Locate the Foam Tape on the Left and Right Side Rails, and remove the paper backing from the foam tape.

Repeat with the both Side Rails.

Assemble the Left Front Side Rail #594.29 and the Left Rear Side Rail #588.41.

Slide the rails together, and secure using two set screws #573.17.


Check and tighten the two (2) set screws in the rear rail. Tighten set screws to 35 in-lbs torque.

Repeat with the Right Side Rails.






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Slide all bows and couplers together before snapping the spring clips into the holes in the bows.

Slide the Couplers installed in the Passenger Side Bow Stack into the ends of the bows on the Drivers Side Bow Stack.

NOTE: Before attaching couplers to bow stacks, make sure to pull the bond coat straps out and away from the bows, and lay them flat.




Step 1

Place the folded Soft Top onto the unfolded Bow Assembly.




Unfold the front and back of the Top over the #1 and #4 Bows.




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Once all zippers are started, flip the rear corners into the rail, then zip all zippers

completely shut.




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


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Section 15 Flip Rear Driver Side Seatbacks Forward; Remove CHMSL



Use the latch on the rear of the driver side rear seatback to release the driver side and middle seatbacks, and flip both seatbacks forward.






Use a T20 Torx Driver to remove the 4 screws that attach the Center High-Mounted Stop Light to the vehicle cab, and remove the CHMSL.

The light housing will remain attached to the wire harness - do not cut any wires at this time.



NOTE: There will be leftover CHMSL wire after running wire to the rear of the vehicle bed. On the inside of the cab, roll the wire bundle up and use wire tie #346.58 to secure it.


The wire bundle can be tucked behind the carpet or trim behind the rear seats.



Unplug the connector between the CHMSL and the wire harness that goes through the vehicle cab where the CHMSL was removed.

Plug both connectors on the Patch Loom into the connectors that you just unplugged coming from the vehicle CHMSL harness.

Use Wire Tie #346.58 to Secure the wire harness to the cab frame behind the CHMSL.




Tools

T20 Torx Driver

Find the four (4) T20 Torx screws you removed earlier, and re-attach the Center High-Mounted Stop Light (CHMSL) to the vehicle cab.
