Your Billy Boat Exhaust system was designed to be a direct replacement exhaust system, while offering the best performance, finish and value available from a stainless steel exhaust system. Proper installation will ensure a lifetime of quality and performance from this product.

- 1) Disconnect the NEG (-) battery terminal.
- 2) Remove the factory exhaust system by removing one side at a time.
- 3) Loosen the small clamp that connects the Cat converter to the muffler.
- 4) Remove the three nuts that hold the existing muffler bracket to the engine. Save the existing nuts, they will be reused. Slip the muffler off the three bracket bolts and lower the muffler out of the vehicle.
- 5) Use the same procedure for the other side.
- 6) Remove the existing three bolt bracket from the existing muffler and install on the B & B mufflers.
- 7) Install the Billy Boat Exhaust system by placing the muffler with the existing three bolt bracket onto the mounts in the vehicle. Hand tighten the existing nuts at this time. Align the muffler tube with the Cat converter exit reusing the existing exhaust clamp and hand tighten. Slip the supplied tip section onto the muffler exit pipe and clamp in place using the supplied clamp. Align the system as needed and tighten the bracket nuts and clamps.
- 8) Repeat the procedure for the other side muffler.
- 9) Reconnect the battery NEG (-) terminal.
- 10) Start vehicle and check for exhaust leaks.

Billy Boat Exhaust Safety

SAFETY: Appropriate disassembly, assembly methods and procedures are essential to ensure the personal safety of the individual performing the kit installation.
