

Exhaust System Installation for BMW 335i Sedan PN-140579, 140580



These instructions have been written to help you with the installation of your Borla <u>Performance Exhaust System</u>. Please read this document completely before beginning the installation of your system.

Please compare the parts in the box with the bill of materials provided to assure that you have all the parts necessary for this installation.

Thank you for purchasing a Borla Performance Exhaust System.

Borla Performance Cat-BackTM Exhaust System PN-(140579, 140580) is designed for the F30 BMW 335i Sedan equipped with a 3.0L Turbo 6-cylinder engine, automatic or manual transmissions.

Borla Performance Industries recommends that an exhaust shop or professional after market parts installer perform the installation of this system. However, if you decide to perform the installation on your own it is recommended that two people are used. This installation should not be performed by one person due to the risk of injury. Ensure the installers use all under car safety precautions including eye protection.


Minimum Required Tool List:

TOOLS:

- 1 3/8" Drive Ratchet
- 2 3/8" Drive Extension 3"
- 3 10mm, 13mm, 15mm Sockets
- 5 Pry Bar

SHOP SUPPLIES:

1 Spray Lubricant





Caution!!! <u>Never work on a hot exhaust system. Serious injury in the form of burns can result</u> If the vehicle has been in use and the exhaust system is hot, allow vehicle to cool for at least 1 hour. Always wear eye protection when working under any vehicle.

Note: It is our recommendation that you use a hoist or hydraulic lift to facilitate the installation of your new Borla Performance Cat-Back[™] Exhaust System.

Taking all under car safety precautions, lift the vehicle using a hoist or hydraulic lift. Once this has been done, you may begin the removal of your old exhaust system from your vehicle.


Note: Before removing the original exhaust system from your vehicle, please compare the parts you have received with the bill of materials provided on the previous page to assure that you have all the parts necessary for the installation of your new Borla Performance Cat-BackTM Exhaust System.


Original Exhaust System Removal

Note: With a used vehicle, we suggest a penetrating spray lubricant to be applied liberally to all exhaust fasteners and allowing a significant period of time for the chemical to lubricate the threads before attempting to disassemble.

- 1. Stock exhaust removes in 1-piece and no cutting is required. Carefully disconnect wire harness from factory exhaust valve. *NOTE: Your new cat-back includes mounting provisions for this valve and harness connection. The valve will not be operative with your new Borla cat-back. (See Fig. 1)*
- 2. Remove cross-brace and keep hardware for re-installation with your new cat-back. (See Fig. 2)
- 3. Using a muffler stand or an additional person to hold the muffler assembly up when removing exhaust hanger bolts. Loosen (2) bolts on front hanger. (See Fig. 3)
- 4. Loosen front muffler clamp. Keep hardware for reinstallation later.
- 5. Loosen (2) bolts on left and right rear muffler hangers. (See Fig. 4)
- 6. Remove the system from the rear. Original rubber isolators are used in the installation of your new exhaust system. (See Fig. 5)
- 7. Reinstall cross-brace and tighten hardware.
- 8. Reinstall (3) hangers from OE exhaust and reinstall to vehicle using factory hardware. Tighten 32-35 ft-lbs.














Borla Performance Cat-BackTM **Exhaust System Installation**

- Refer to Page 2 drawing. Re-install the electronic exhaust valve to Rear Muf-1. fler Assembly using provided hardware. Tighten hardware 32-35 ft. lbs.
- 2. Install Front Pipe Assembly inserting hangers into factory rubber isolators. Reinstall factory hardware and tighten 18-20 ft.lbs. (See Fig. 6A & 6B)
- 3. Place a clamp over the Mid Muffler Assembly and place inlet over Front Pipe Assembly. LIGHTLY TIGHTEN CLAMP BOLT.
- Place a clamp over the Intermediate Pipe Assembly and place pipe inlet over 4 Mid-Pipe Assembly. LIGHTLY TIGHTEN CLAMP BOLT. (See Fig. 7)
- 5. Place a clamp over the Rear Muffler Assembly and place pipe inlet over Intermediate Pipe Assembly. Carefully insert hangers into rubber isolators. LIGHT-LY TIGHTEN CLAMP BOLT. (See Fig. 8)
- Place a clamp over the RH Tail Pipe Assembly and place pipe inlet over right-6. side of muffler. Carefully insert hangers into rubber isolators. LIGHTLY TIGHTEN CLAMP BOLT. (See Fig. 8)
- Check your exhaust system for proper clearance under the vehicle and also for 7. tip alignment. (See Fig. 10) Once position has been determined to be correct, tighten the Accuseal[™] clamp 32-35 ft. lbs. Tighten the OE clamp bolts. NOTE: When properly clamped, the Accuseal pipe closes with interlocking notches creating a proper seal.

- Before starting your vehicle, make sure to check all wires, hoses, brake lines, 9. body parts and tires for safe clearance from the exhaust system.
- 10. Start vehicle and check for any leaks. If any leaks are found, determine cause (such as loose or incorrectly positioned clamp) and repair as necessary.

Note: When you first start your vehicle after the installation of your new Borla Performance Exhaust System, there may be some smoke and fumes coming from the system. This is a protective oil based coating used in the manufacturing of mandrel bent performance exhaust tubing. This is not a problem and will disappear within a very short period of time after the exhaust has reached normal operating temperatures.
