



STEP 1 – PRIOR TO INSTALLATION

- A) Bushwacker[®] only approves installing the Mud Flaps using the hardware provided. WARNING: Failure to install using this hardware will invalidate the warranty. DO NOT USE: Loctite, SuperGlue, or similar products on the hardware or the mud flaps.
- **B)** Fit: Verify the fit of the Mud Flaps to your flares. (Some filing, sanding, may be necessary to ensure proper fit). Clean your fender flares of dirt and debris.
- C) Exhaust System: Modifications may be necessary to maintain a minimum 4" clearance between Mud Flaps and exhaust pipes. (Exhaust gases should not vent directly onto Mud Flaps)
- D) Metal Protection: All exposed fasteners and bare metal should be treated with rust resistant paint BEFORE installing Mud Flaps.



To claim a warranty, you must provide Proof of Purchase.



Identify which of the enclosed fasteners best suits your Fender Flare and Mud Flap combination. Hold the Mud Flap up to your Bushwacker[®] Fender Flare and mark the hole locations using a grease pencil. Pre-drill holes in the Fender Flare where you will use plastic push fasteners. Pre-drilled holes are not necessary if using screws.

Secure the mud flap to the Bushwacker[®] fender flare by inserting fasteners through the pre-drilled holes in the Mud Flap. Some applications utilize pre-existing hardware locations that line up with fasteners on your Bushwacker[®] Fender Flares. In these cases it will be necessary to remove the fastener and reinsert it with the Mud Flap in place.
