

Installation Instructions

#77-272 - Mini Cooper Gen 1 Power Steering Tank

NOTE: We recommend removing the coolant tank to ease installation.

- 1. Drain the fluid from both the coolant tank and the power steering tank.
- 2. Unbolt the coolant tank and remove the hose on top of the tank.
- Once the tank is unbolted and the top hose is removed you will have the ability to pull the tank up and get to the bottom hose to remove it.
- 4. After the coolant tank is removed you will need to unbolt the power steering tank and remove both hoses on the bottom of the tank.
- The rubber grommets from the stock tank NOTE: must be used. To remove you will first need to remove the metal sleeve inside.
- We recommend replacing the hose NOTE: clamps while replacing the tank in order to prevent any leaks.
- 5. Install the power steering tank by attaching the hoses first.
- 6. Be sure to feed the coolant line through the power steering bracket before bolting the power steering tank in.
 - Reinstall the coolant tank by attaching the hoses first.
 - 8. Refill fluids and put the caps on and you are finished.
