Installation Instructions

T-Connector





 Locate the tow vehicle's trailer harness connector. The gray 6-pin plug is located under the vehicle, behind the rear bumper on the driver's side, along the frame rail ().

2. Tow Plug Replacement

A. Remove the original OEM wiring harness from connector (3). All connector surfaces should be clean and free of dirt.

New Installation

- A. Remove the protective cap from connector. All connector surfaces should be clean and free of dirt.
- 3. Connect the T-Connector end to the vehicle's mating connector. Be careful not to damage the locking tabs and be sure that connectors are fully inserted with locking tabs in place.

4. Nissan Xterra without Tow Package

A. Taillight function on the tow plug will not work unless an OEM relay harness (not included) is purchased. See Nissan Dealer for more information.

WARNING

All connections must be complete for the T-Connector to function properly. Test and verify installation with a test light or trailer once installed.

Overloading circuit can cause fires. DO NOT exceed lower of towing manufacturer rating or:
Max. stop/turn light: 1 per side (7.5 amps)
Max. tail lights: (7.5 amps)
Read vehicle's owners manual & instruction


