## Installation Instructions

# **T-Connector**





 Locate the vehicle's tail light wiring harness underneath the truck bed near the driver's side frame rail (). This harness will have a connection point with connectors matching the ends of the T-connector harness.



- 2. Separate the vehicle's connectors **B**, being careful not to break the locking tabs. Check to see that the mating surfaces of the connectors are free of dirt and clean If necessary.
- **3.** Insert the T-connector harness between the vehicle's connectors.
- 4. Locate a suitable grounding point near the connectors such as the vehicle's frame or crossmember (Do not drill into vehicle floor or bed). Clean dirt and rustproofing from area. Drill a 3/32" hole and secure white wire with eyelet using screw provided.

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Verify what is behind any surface prior to drilling to avoid damage to the vehicle and/or personal injury. Do not drill into any exposed surfaces.

5. Route the T-connector harness to the center of the vehicle and secure wire to vehicle crossmember or other mountings point using electrical tape or tie straps (not provided).

## **WARNING**

All connections must be complete for the T-Connector to function properly. Test and verify installation with a test light or trailer once installed.

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Overloading circuit can cause fires. DO NOT exceed lower of towing manufacturer rating or: • Max. stop/turn light: 1 per side (2.1 amps)

• Max. tail lights: (5 amps)
