



To wash and dry microfiber goods:

How To Use:

Clean and soft microfiber is crucial to preventing scratches on paint. Use Chemical Guys Microfiber Wash to keep your microfiber towels clean, soft, and absorbent!

- Separate microfiber towels by type into designated wash & dry loads.
  - Keep grimy towels separate from cleaner paint towels! Start by washing "cleaner" towels first, then finish with "grimier" towels.

Hot water opens the fibers to better release dirt and grease.

- Machine wash microfiber goods with Chemical Guys Microfiber Wash and HOT water. Add 1 ounce for small wash loads; 2 ounces for medium loads; or 3 or more for large wash loads
- Do not use fabric softener: fabric softeners clog microfiber and render them unabsorbent and useless. Machine dry microfiber goods on LOW heat.
  - High heat cooks fibers, makes them hard, and then they can scratch paint. Do not use fabric softener dryer sheets: fabric softeners clog microfiber and render them unabsorbent and useless.
