- Separate microfiber towels by type into designated wash & dry loads.
 - Keep grimy towels separate from cleaner paint towels!
- Start by washing "cleaner" towels first, then finish with "grimier" towels. · Machine wash microfiber goods with Chemical Guys Microfiber Wash and HOT water.
 - Hot water opens the fibers to better release dirt and grease.
- Do not use fabric softener: fabric softeners clog microfiber and render them unabsorbent and useless. Machine dry microfiber goods on LOW heat.
 - High heat cooks fibers, makes them hard, and then they can scratch paint. Do not use fabric softener dryer sheets: fabric softeners clog microfiber and render them unabsorbent and useless.
