

 - Do not use fabric softener: fabric softeners clog microfiber and render them unabsorbent and useless.
- Machine dry microfiber goods on LOW heat.
 - · High heat cooks fibers, makes them hard, and then they can scratch paint. Do not use fabric softener dryer sheets: fabric softeners clog microfiber and render them unabsorbent and useless.
