Polish metals like chrome, stainless steel, and polished aluminum with the Gray Workhorse Towel. Restore shine and reflection to metal parts inside any vehicle, on the outside, or in the engine bay. Polish bumpers, trim pieces, headlight bezels, grilles, radiator housings, air filters, hubcaps, exhaust tips, wheels, and more with the Gray Workhorse Towel. Use the soft towel to pick up dirt, dust, water spots, and grime. Gray Workhorse Towels are soft and will not scratch sensitive metal finishes on bumpers, door handles, hubcaps, or wheels. Polish metal parts with a Gray Workhorse Towel and any Chemical Guys Metal Polish to remove oxidation, stains, water spots, chemical etching, and to restore a mirror reflection and gloss. Dry off wheels after a deep-wheel detail with the Gray Workhorse Towel to protect any sensitive paint, clear coat, powder coat, or polished metal finishes. Keep Your Towels Clean And Soft

Clean and soft microfiber is crucial to preventing scratches on paint. Use Chemical Guys **Microfiber Wash** to keep your microfiber towels clean, soft, and absorbent! To wash and dry microfiber goods:

- Separate microfiber towels by type into designated wash & dry loads.
 - Keep grimy towels separate from cleaner paint towels!
 - Start by washing "cleaner" towels first, then finish with "grimier" towels.
- Machine wash microfiber goods with Chemical Guys Microfiber Wash and HOT water.
 - Hot water opens the fibers to better release dirt and grease.
 - Do not use fabric softener: fabric softeners clog microfiber and render them unabsorbent and useless.
- Machine dry microfiber towels on LOW heat.
 - High heat cooks fibers, makes them hard, and then they can scratch paint.
 - Do not use fabric softener dryer sheets: fabric softeners clog microfiber and render them unabsorbent and useless.
