

**Clayton Off Road

Refer to pictures below.

Step 1: Remove old control arm on one side.

Step 2: Remove shock bolt.

Step 3: Position axle.

Step 4: Measure length from axle side mount to frame side mount.

Step 5: Adjust control arm to length and run jam nut up to control arm tube insert.

Step 6: Install new control arm with adjustment end on frame.

Step 7: Install control arm bolts and nuts.

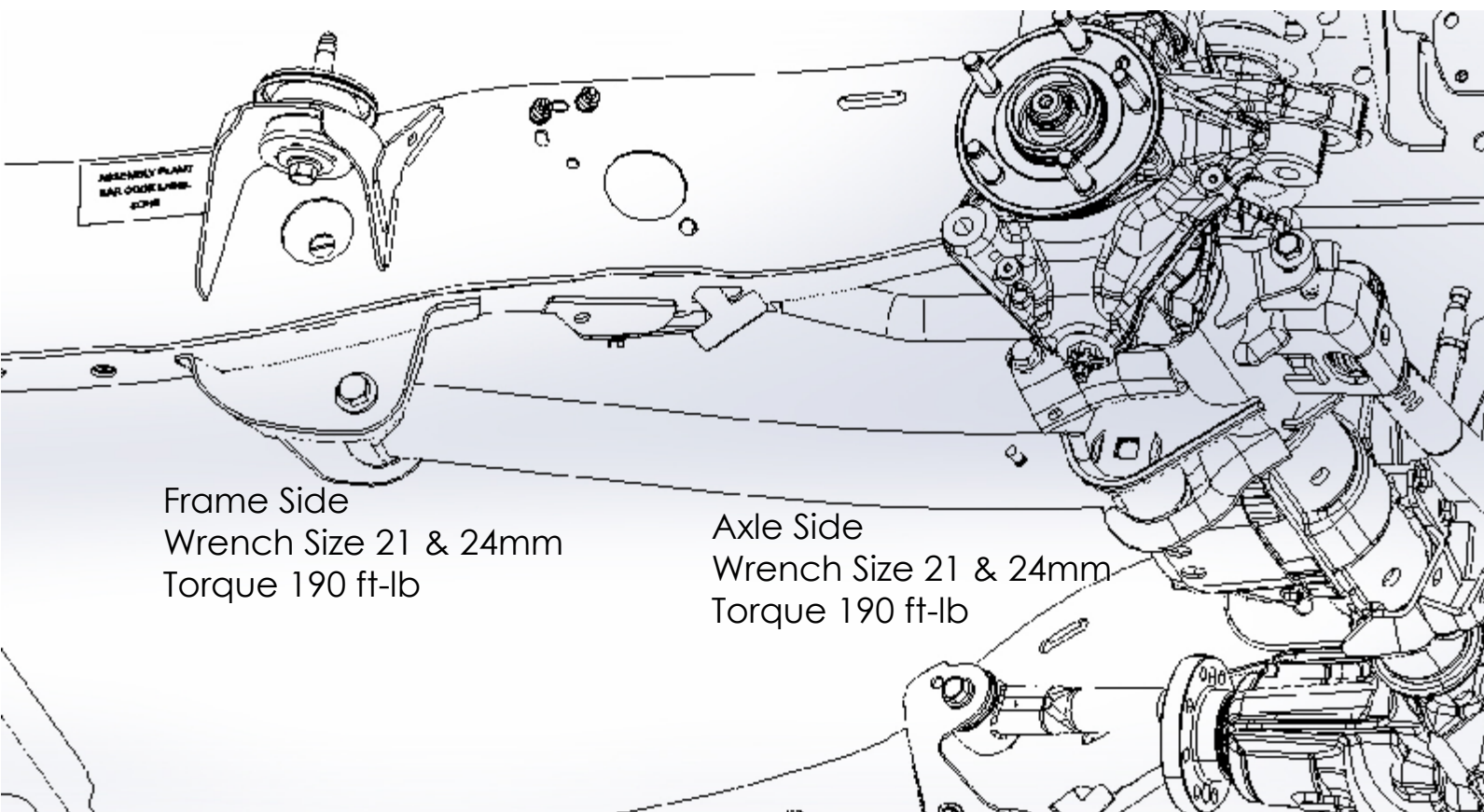
Step 8: Torques both bolts to 190 ft-lb.

Step 9: Tighten jam nut using a 46mm or 1-13/16" wrench.

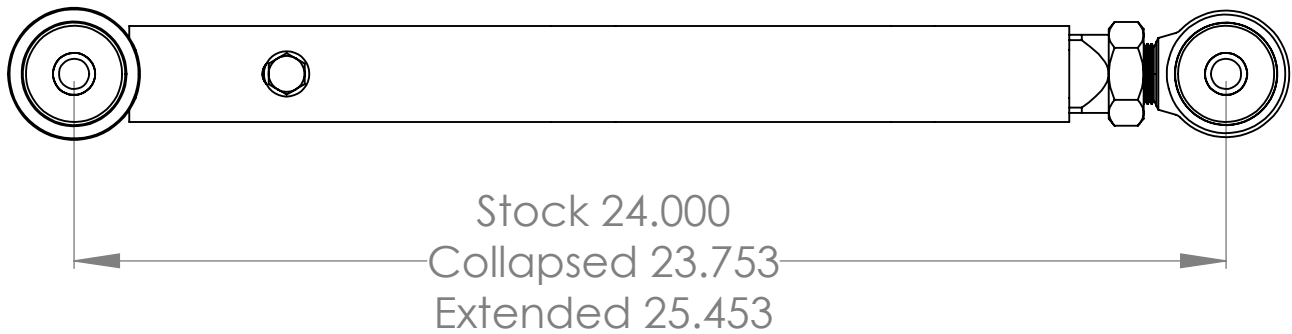
Step 10: Bolt brake line clip to control arm.

Step 11: Install new shock bolt, nut and washers.

Step 12: Repeat steps 1 to 11 on other side.
