

513 - Subaru Crank Socket Tool Instructions

- **WARNING:** Never use an impact wrench with the crank socket to rotate the engine. Keyway damage will occur.

LOOSENING INSTRUCTIONS:

Step 1) For instructions on removing and installing crankshaft sprocket, see Company23 Crank Pulley Tool Manual.

Step 2) Place socket on crankshaft snout and fully seat the socket. Be sure that the crankshaft key is in place on the crankshaft.

Step 3) Insert ½" ratchet into crank socket.



Step 3) Always rotate the engine in a clockwise direction to prevent the timing belt from skipping.
