


PRODUCT CARE: Dry Filter (DryTech 3D)







Cleaning your DryTech 3D: One of the benefits of using a DryTech 3D filter is that you can clean and reuse it. Depending on driving and environmental conditions; the filter will become caked with dirt and require cleaning. It is recommended to clean the filter on your CORSA Intake at least two times a year. Replacement filters are available through CORSA. Also, if you experience a sudden decrease in mileage or engine performance, the filter will need to be cleaned.

QUICK CLEANING:

-  **1.** Vacuum free debris from the surface of the filter.
- 2.** Remove the filter from your air intake and tap it on a hard surface to remove any loose dirt.

DO NOT OIL! Oiling your Dry filter will ruin its effectiveness and require immediate replacement.

DEEP CLEANING:

-  **1.** Vacuum free debris from the surface of the filter.
- 2.** Remove the filter from your air intake and tap it on a hard surface to remove any loose dirt.
-  **3.** Liberally spray the filter with filter cleaner and allow it to soak in for about 10 minutes. Avoid petroleum based products because they will soften and destroy sealing edges.
-  **4.** Rinse off the dirt from the inside of the filter out. Never use high pressure nozzles or air; they could tear and distort the cotton gauze media.
-  **5.** Allow the filter to air dry in a clean area. Never use applied heat or an air vent to dry the filter. **Do NOT** reinstall a wet or damp filter. The oiled filter must be completely dry before it is installed.

DO NOT OIL! Oiling your Dry filter will ruin its effectiveness and require immediate replacement.
