INSTALLATION DIAGRAM: RED Wire (A)* WHITE Wire To Aftermarket Radio GROUND Parking Guideline Backup Camera Input OR Extension Coax Cable Make sure the arrows Regulator Reverse Camera Interface line up and push in Backup Camera Input the connectors well RED Wire (B)* LICENSE PLATE

***NOTE:** To power the camera, use RED Wire A or B. If tapping power from the radio or RVC Interface, make sure to insulate RED Wire A to avoid it from shorting. If you will be tapping power from the reverse light +12V, insulate RED Wire B to avoid it from shorting. With either connection the Black GROUND wire needs to be connected to a solid chassis ground. For vehicles with manual transmission, we recommend tapping +12V power from the reverse light.

WHITE Wire: Connect to show parking guide line. Disconnect to remove. Insulate with tape to avoid from shorting.

INSTALLATION PROCEDURE:

- 1. Remove the stock license plate light at the back of the vehicle.
- 2. Install the camera assembly to where the stock license plate light was.
- 3. Connect the built-in license plate light of the camera to the stock license plate power connection.
- 4. Connect the power of the camera to your reverse light wires:

Red wire to +12V

- Black wire to Ground
- 5. Connect the video cable of the camera to the extension cord provided.
- 6. Run the video extension cable to the back of the radio.
- 7. Connect the video cable to your in-dash aftermarket multimedia or navigation receiver's camera input.
- 8. Put the gear in reverse to see the image from the camera.
