

- 2. Remove lower front cross member (if equipped).
- 3. Place receiver hitch inside bumper and line up outside holes. See figure 1.
- 4. Using the hitch as a template mark the required drill holes. Drill holes with 5/8" drill bit. See figure 2.
- 5. Place hitch over the ends of frame rails.
- 6. Reinstall lower front cross member and tow hooks (if equipped).
- 7. Reinstall bumper using (4) bolts removed in step 1. Do not install shim plates and return to customer.
- 8. Place 1/2"-13 x 1 3/4" bolts along with a 1/2" washers in (4) drilled holes. Secure with SP16 spacers and 1/2"-13 handle nut as shown. **CAUTION:** Hold drivers side handle nuts in place to prevent them from rotating into air conditioning condenser.
- 9. Torque all 1/2" fasteners to 110 lb-ft.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.
