FISHWIRE TECHNIQUE

PISHWIRE TECHNIQUE INSERT COILED END OF FISHWIRE TOOL THROUGH HITCH MOUNTING HOLE IN VEHICLE FRAME RAIL AND OUT THE ACESS HOLE. PASS COILE DO OF FISHWIRE THROUGH SPACER AND THREAD BOLT INTO COIL. KINK WIRE TO KEER SPACER, SAPB BOLT AS SHOWN. PULL FISHWIRE TACEAR SPACE AND OUT MOUNTING HOLE. USE FISHWIRE TO GUIDE HITCH DURING MOUNTING AND PREVENT LOSS OF BOLT / SPACER INSIDE FRAME RAIL. "NOTE: SOME VEHICLES MAY FISHWIRE THROUGH END OF FRAME"

INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1) Remove bumper bracket bolts from bottom of each frame rail FASTNERS WILL NOT BE REUSED Return to vehicle owner.
- 2) Raise hitch into position and install M10 bolt assemblies through hitch into existing weldnuts. HAND TIGHTEN ONLY. Discard M10 shipping nuts.
- 3) Using the tabs on the hitch as guides, drill (two) 7/16" holes in the bottom of the bumper. Note: Bumper material is very tough and difficult to drill. Use 7/16" carbide drill bit.
- 4) Drill a 1/4" hole and a 1" access hole in bottom of bumper inboard of each tab on hitch. The 1 x 2 block will fit through the 1" hole alone. Note: On some models there is a rectangular hole that can be used for fishwiring and the 1" access hole will not have to be drilled.
- 5) Fishwire through each access hole a 7/16" carriage bolt and block. Attach a flat washer, lock washer, and nut.

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- 6) Check to see if receiver tube is level. Variations in bumper position may make it necessary to add a spacer (provided) between hitch side arm and frame rail, TIGHTEN BOLTS.
- 7) Torgue M10 fasteners to 45 LB.-FT. and 7/16" fasteners to 70 LB.-FT.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.
