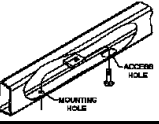

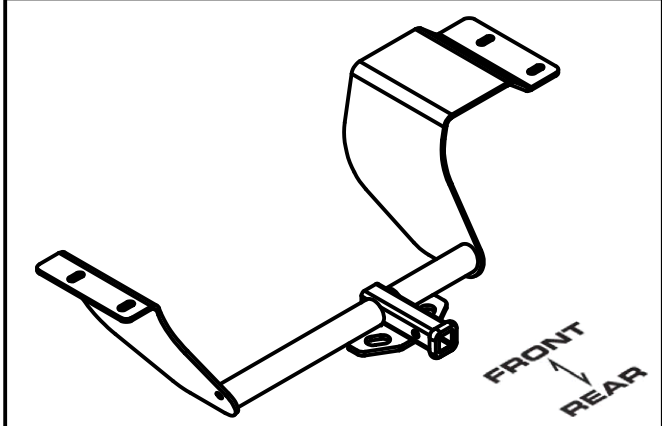

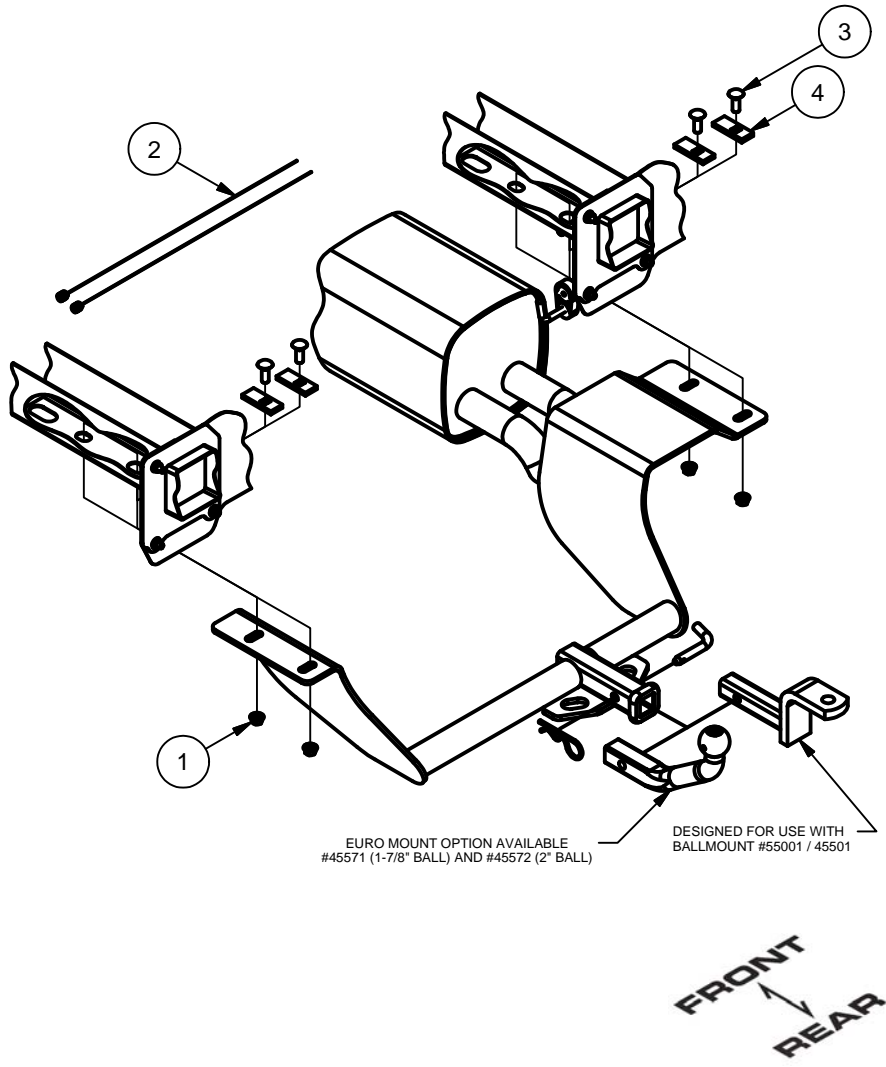

1. Lower exhaust by removing (2) rubber isolators from the hangers attached to the frame.



### RUBBER ISOLATOR REMOVAL DIAGRAM

This technique can be used if an Exhaust Hanger Removal Pliers is not available.

Using a 5/8" open end wrench, slide the wrench up to the rubber isolator, cradling the hanger rod as shown. Next place the flat edge of a pry bar between the wrench and the hanger stop or hanger rod. Then simply rotate the pry bar toward the wrench to remove the rubber isolator.

Note: Using a spray lubricant or soapy water on the hanger rod and the rubber isolator helps removal.



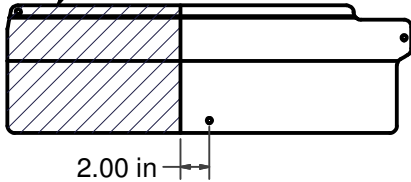
2. Remove (3) fasteners securing the heat shield and remove.



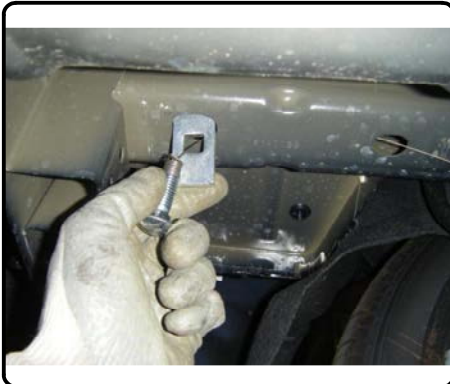
## INSTALLATION WALKTHROUGH:

3. Mark and trim heat shield. Reattach heat shield using fasteners removed in Step (2).

**NOTE:** DIMENSIONS ARE APPROXIMATE, CONFIRM FIT PRIOR TO TRIMMING



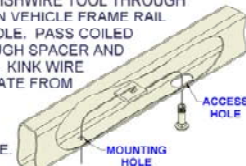
4. Fishwire 7/16-14 x 1 1/4" carriage bolt and SP11 spacer through the rear most hole in the frame and out the next hole towards the front, both sides.



### FISHWIRE TECHNIQUE

INSERT COILED END OF FISHWIRE TOOL THROUGH HITCH MOUNTING HOLE IN VEHICLE FRAME RAIL AND OUT THE ACCESS HOLE. PASS COILED END OF FISHWIRE THROUGH SPACER AND THREAD BOLT INTO COIL. KINK WIRE TO KEEP SPACER SEPERATE FROM BOLT AS SHOWN. PULL FISHWIRE, SPACER, AND BOLT THROUGH FRAME AND OUT MOUNTING HOLE AND OUT MOUNTING HOLE USE FISHWIRE TO GUIDE HITCH DURING MOUNTING AND PREVENT LOSS OF BOLT / SPACER INSIDE FRAME RAIL.

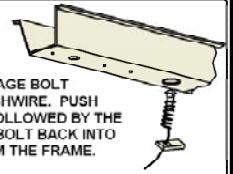


5. Reverse fishwire 7/16-14 x 1 1/4" carriage bolt and SP11 spacer into the rear most hole, both sides.

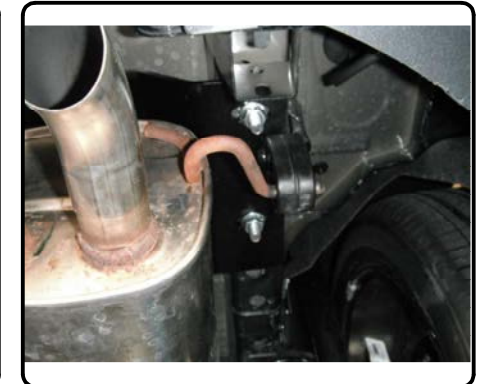
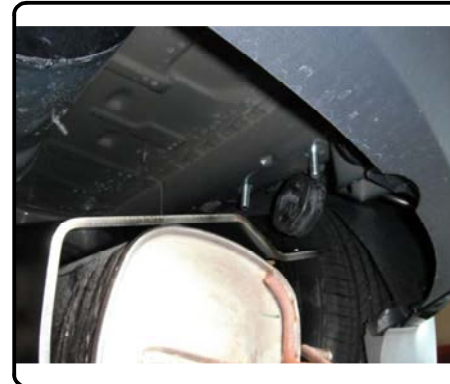


### REVERSE PULL FISHWIRE TECHNIQUE

ATTACH FISHWIRE TO CARRIAGE BOLT AND SLIDE SPACER ONTO FISHWIRE. PUSH THE BOLT THRU THE HOLE FOLLOWED BY THE SPACER (AS SHOWN). PULL BOLT BACK INTO POSITION, PROTRUDING FROM THE FRAME.



6. Raise hitch over the exhaust and slide it past the exhaust hanger. Secure hitch using 7/16-14 flange nuts. **Note:** When raising hitch into position you may have to push bolts part way back into the frame to get the plates into position. You may use fishwires to guide hitch during mounting to prevent the loss of bolts and spacers inside the frame rails.



## INSTALLATION WALKTHROUGH:

7. Torque all 7/16" hardware to 10 ft-lbs.  
Raise exhaust back into position.



Hitch installation is complete.

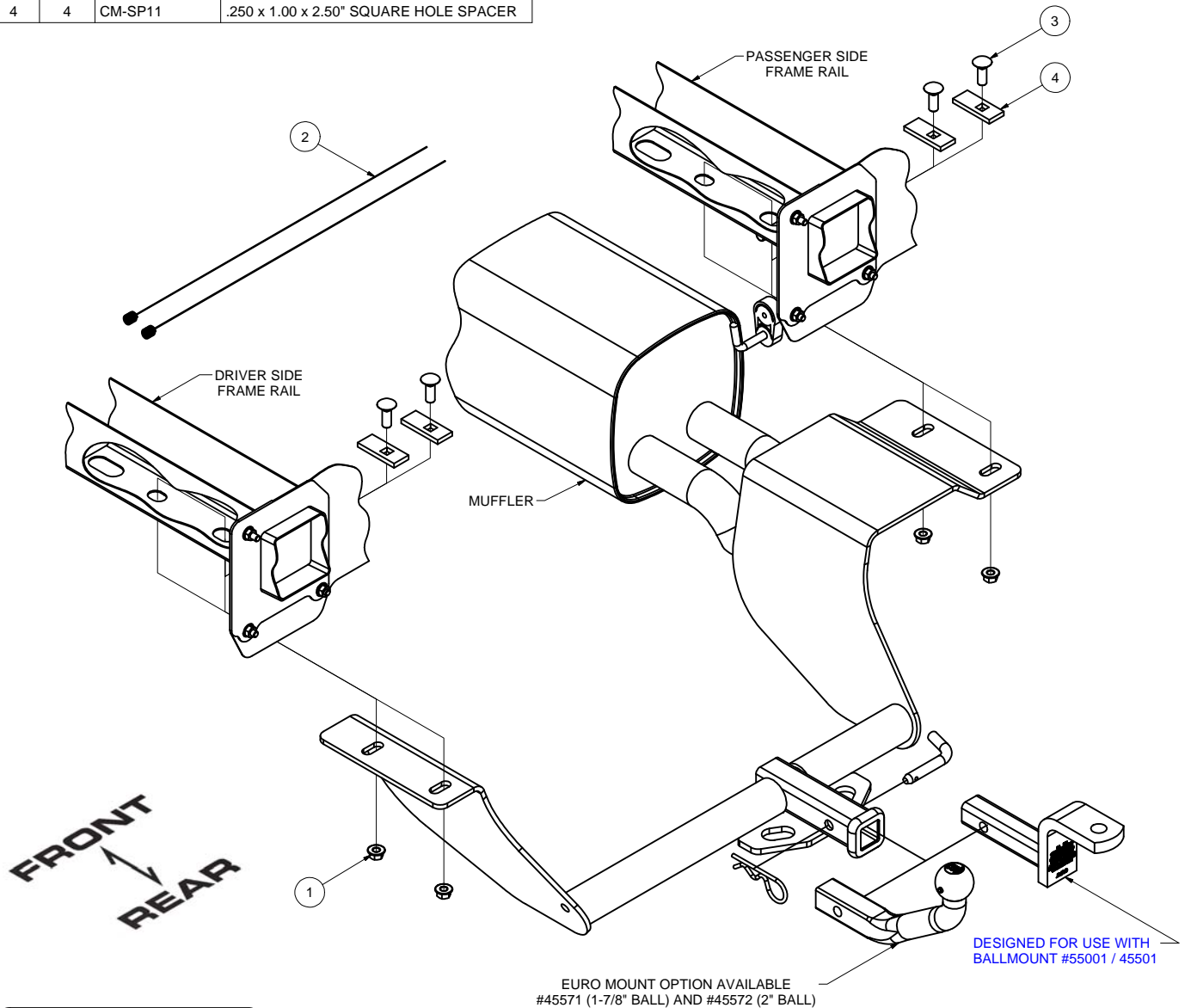

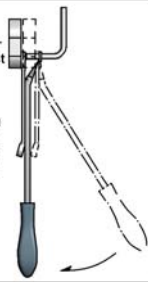

**RUBBER ISOLATOR  
REMOVAL DIAGRAM**

This technique can be used if and Exhaust Hanger Removal Pliers is not available.

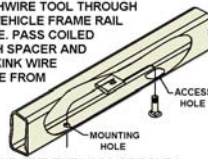

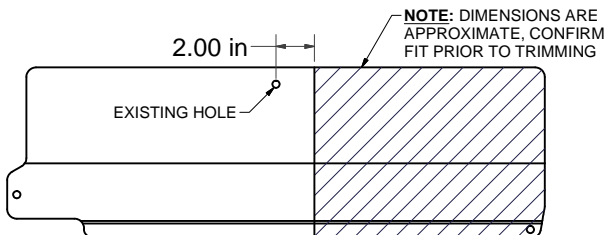
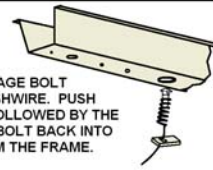
**FISHWIRE TECHNIQUE**

INSERT COILED END OF FISHWIRE TOOL THROUGH HITCH MOUNTING HOLE IN VEHICLE FRAME RAIL AND OUT THE ACCESS HOLE. PASS COILED END OF FISHWIRE THROUGH SPACER AND THREAD BOLT INTO COIL. KINK WIRE TO KEEP SPACER SEPERATE FROM BOLT AS SHOWN. PULL FISHWIRE, SPACER, AND BOLT THROUGH FRAME AND OUT MOUNTING HOLE. USE FISHWIRE TO GUIDE HITCH DURING MOUNTING AND PREVENT LOSS OF BOLT / SPACER INSIDE FRAME RAIL.

**REVERSE PULL FISHWIRE  
TECHNIQUE**

ATTACH FISHWIRE TO CARRIAGE BOLT AND SLIDE SPACER ONTO FISHWIRE. PUSH THE BOLT THRU THE HOLE FOLLOWED BY THE SPACER (AS SHOWN). PULL BOLT BACK INTO POSITION, PROTRUDING FROM THE FRAME.



HEAT SHIELD TRIM DIAGRAM

**TOOLS REQUIRED**

RATCHET
TORQUE WRENCH
9" EXTENSION
10mm SOCKET
11/16" SOCKET
AVIATION SHEARS

**INSTALLATION STEPS**

1. Lower exhaust by removing (2) rubber isolators from the hangers attached to the frame. (See Rubber Isolator Removal Diagram)
2. Remove (3) fasteners securing the heat shield and remove.
3. Mark and trim heat shield. Reattach heat shield using fasteners removed in Step (2). (See Heat Shield Trim Diagram)
4. Fishwire 7/16-14 x 1 1/4" carriage bolt and SP11 spacer through the rear most hole in the frame and out the next hole towards the front, both sides. (See Fishwire Technique)
5. Reverse fishwire 7/16-14 x 1 1/4" carriage bolt and SP11 spacer into the rear most hole, both sides. (See Reverse Fishwire Technique)
6. Raise hitch over the exhaust and slide it past the exhaust hanger. Secure hitch using 7/16-14 flange nuts.  
**Note:** When raising hitch into position you may have to push bolts part way back into the frame to get the plates into position. You may use fishwires to guide hitch during mounting to prevent the loss of bolts and spacers inside the frame rail.
7. Torque all 7/16" hardware to 70 ft-lbs.
8. Raise exhaust back into position.
