

PUSH THE BOLT THRU THE HOLE FOLLOWED BY THE SPACER (AS SHOWN). PULL BOLT BACK INTO compressed air into hole. For heavy debris, use a small wire brush. POSITION, PROTRUDING FROM THE FRAME. INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1. Locate and remove rubber cap from mounting hole on driver side frame rail. (Discard cap.)
- 2. Locate and remove rear rubber cap from mounting hole on passenger side frame rail. (Discard cap.)
- Enlarge driver and passenger side mounting holes enough to allow 1/2-13 carriage bolts and CM-SP6 spacers to pass through. (See HOLE ENLARGEMENT DIAGRAM.)
- Reverse fishwire 1/2-13 carriage bolts and CM-SP6 spacers through mounting holes, as shown. Leave fishwires attached to hardware for ease of hitch installation. (See REVERSE PULL FISHWIRE TECHNIQUE diagram.)
- 5. Lower exhaust by removing two (2) M8 bolts per exhaust hanger bracket assembly on driver and passenger side of vehicle. (Discard factory M8 bolts.)
- 6. Raise hitch over exhaust and reattach exhaust hangers with supplied M8 hex bolts and 3/8 in. conical toothed washers, as shown. The hitch side plates will be located between the exhaust hanger brackets and frame rails.
- 7. Remove fishwires from Step 4 and secure hitch with 1/2-13 hex flange nuts.
- 8. Torque 1/2 in. hardware to 75 lb-ft and M8 hardware to 17 lb-ft.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.
