





RUBBER ISOLATOR REMOVAL DIAGRAM

This technique can be used if and Exhaust Hanger Removal Pliers is not available.

Using a 5/8" open end wrench, slide the wrench up to the rubber isolator, cradling the hanger rod as shown. Next place the flat edge of a pry bar between the wrench and the hanger stop or hanger rod. Then simply rotate the pry bar toward the wrench to remove the rubber isolator.

Note: Using a spray lubricant or soapy water on the hanger rod and the rubber isolator helps removal.

INSTALLATION WALKTHROUGH:

1. Temporarily remove (4) plastic fasteners and (4) hex screws from fascia.





 Lower exhaust by removing (3) rubber isolators. See RUBBER ISOLATOR REMOVAL DIAGRAM on page 2.
 (Note: Support exhaust to avoid possible damage.)





3. Temporarily remove heat shield by removing (4) nuts. (**Note**: If tow loop is present remove and return to vehicle owner.)





4. Insert 4" hex bolts with washers into the frame rails from the outside. Raise the hitch into position between the frame rails. Push front bolts through mounting plates and loosely install 1/2" flange nuts.








5. Rotate hitch up so that it is touching fascia and mark where to trim.





6. Trim fascia. See TRIM DIAGRAM on page 2. (Note: Check fit prior to completing trim)






7. Install remaining 1/2" bolts and secure hitch with hex flange nuts. Torque all 1/2" fasteners to 75 ft-lbs.





8. Reinstall heat shield, fasteners, and exhaust.








