

INSTALLATION STEPS

If vehicle is equipped with an OEM Tow Hook: Remove permanently for hitch installation. Install time will increase from 30 to 90 minutes.

- Lower spare tire to allow access to the rear bumper support.
- 2. Remove (6) plastic fasteners from bumper fascia tabs. (Reuse later)
- 3. Gently pull bumper cover away from vehicle and raise hitch into position. Secure hitch with hex bolts and conical washers through existing holes in bumper support.
- 4. Torque all 1/2" fasteners to 75 lb-ft.
- 5. Reinstall plastic push fasteners and bumper cover removed in step 2.
- 6. Raise spare tire back into position.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.
