

INSTALLATION STEPS

Note: To ease installation, removal of the spare tire is recommended.

- 1. Position the hitch against the frame, aligning the holes in the hitch with the holes in the frame. Take note of the fastener locations and lower the hitch.
- 2. Place a carriage bolt and spacer into each bolt location from inside the frame rail as shown.
- 3. Raise the hitch into position and secure it to the frame rails using flat washers, lock washers and hex nuts as shown.
- 4. Torque all hardware to 150 lb-ft.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.
