## WIRING LOCATION GUIDE



MUST READ FIRST!

All steps must be followed to ensure correct function of the T-Connector. To verify proper installation once installed, test by connecting a test light or properly wired trailer.

- 1. Remove rear trim fascia and rear interior trim panels(if equipped) near the rear entry doors. A&B Locate the vehicles taillight wiring harness. B The taillight wiring harness will have connection points matching the ends of the T-connector.
- 2. Disconnect the vehicle wiring harness connectors on the driver side, being careful not to damage the locking tabs. C
- 3. Plug the T-connector end with the yellow wire in-between the mating plugs on on the drivers side taillight socket and vehicle wiring harness. D Ensure that the connectors are fully inserted together utilizing existing and supplied locking tabs.
- 4. Locate a suitable grounding point near the harness such as an existing metal screw with nut. D If no such feature exists, drill a 3/32" hole and secure white wire using eyelet and screw provided.
- 5. Repeat steps 2 & 3 on the passenger's side with the T-connector end containing the green wire.
- 6. Tuck the green wire under the floor trim (threshold) panel. Replace the vehicle's rear trim panels.


