Always use a proper vehicle lift when installing Cusco Sway Bars. Always follow OSHA safety standards when working on or under a vehicle.


This installation manual serves as a general guideline for Cusco product install. Please refer to the factory service manual for the proper procedure for installation.

### [Procedure]

- 1.) Remove jack up lift plate. (Also emove support arm for Spec C models)
- 2.) Remove subframe. (None present on Spec C models)
- 3.) Remove sway bar end links.
- 4.) Remove sway bar mounts.
- 5.) Remove sway bar unit.
- 6.) Installation is performed in reverse order of removal. Do not re-use the factory bushings, please use the included Cusco bushings.
  - \*Please refer to the manufacturer factory service manual for torque specififcations.







#### Stabilizer / Anti-Sway Bar









When the lifting point is bent in or crushed like pictured above, there is a possibility of the Sway Bar making contact while the vehicle is in operation. Please return the Jack-up lift point to normal conditions before proceeding.

In the case for Spec C models

A bent support bar that lies between the member and jack-up point may become bent or crushed. Please fix this area beforee proceeding.

<sup>\*\*</sup>Periodically check and re-torque all nuts and bolts after operating vehicle.
