It is the sole responsibility of the vehicle owner to check for tire clearance. It is unlawful and dangerous to ride on any external vehicle step while the vehicle is in motion.














First remove the 4 bolts in the driver's side cowl using a T40 Torx on the side and a T35 Torx on the top.



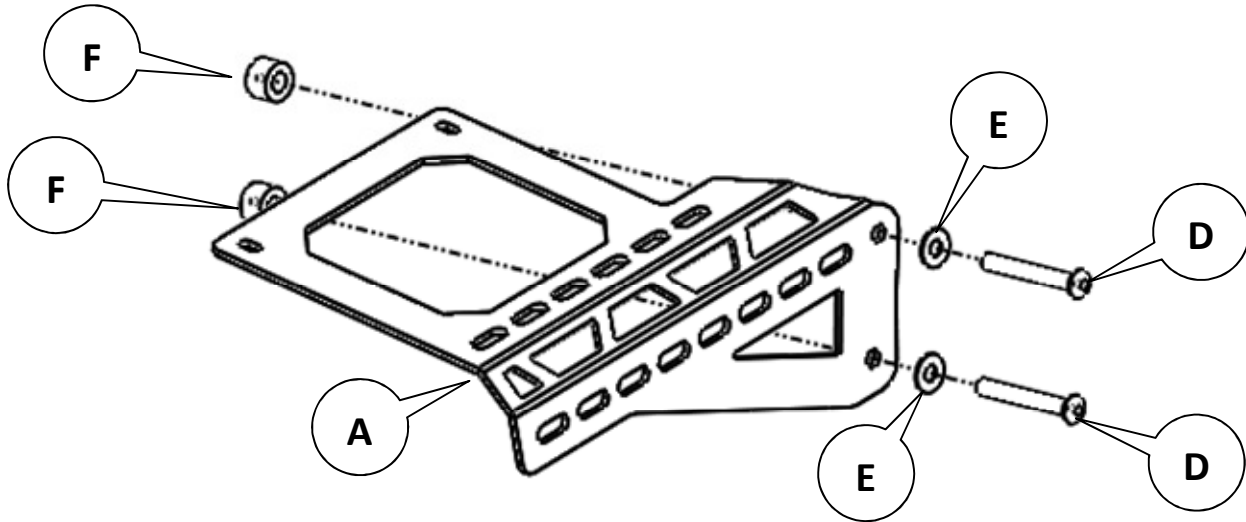

Set a plastic washer (K) in both of the upper locations of the cowl.

Install bolts (D), washers (E), and spacers (F) through the lower holes of the driver side bracket (A).



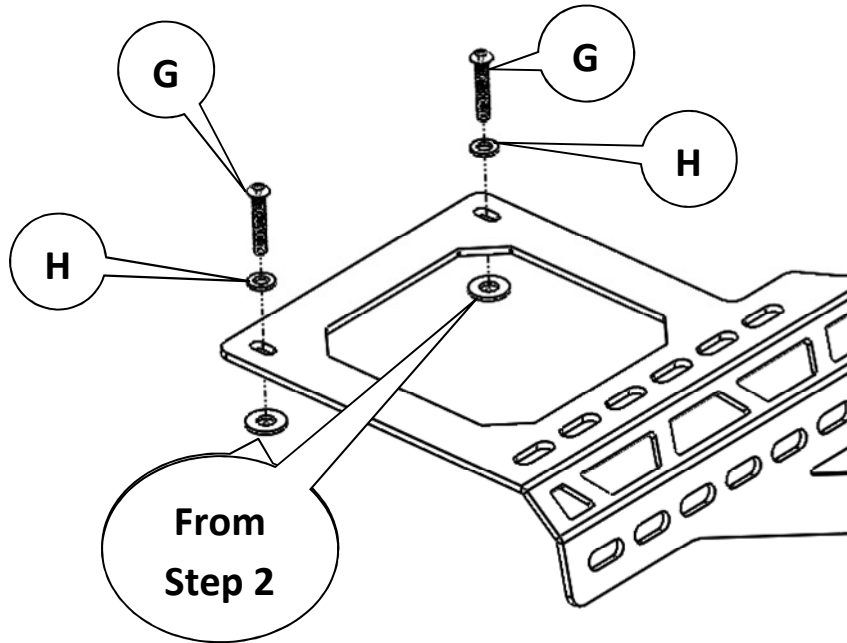

Install the bolts from the previous step into the lower holes of the cowl. Do not fully tighten at this time.

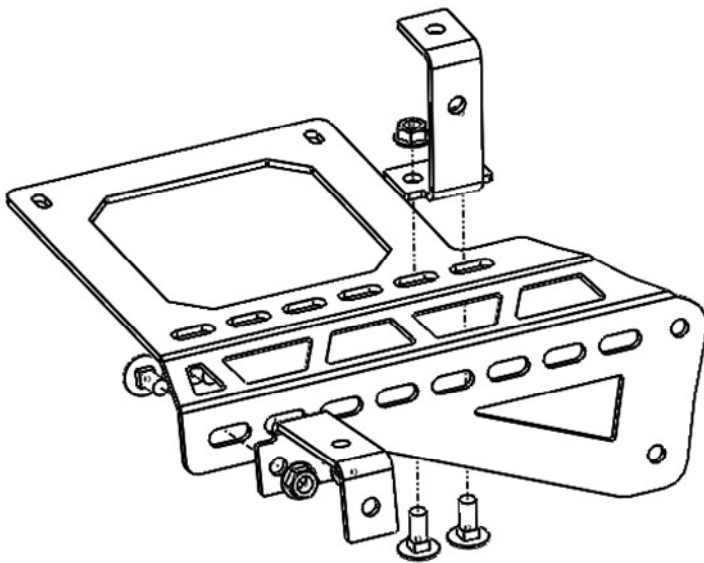

Install bolts (G) and washers (H) through the bracket and washers in the upper locations of the cowl. Fully tighten the lower bolts then tighten the upper bolts.

Mounting the accessory mount bracket (C) is optional. If you want to mount the accessory mount bracket locate the desired position on the drivers bracket in either the top or side slots. Then install bolt (I) from the bottom side, through the bracket, and use nut (J). Fully tighten bracket.



When bracket or any accessory is mounted on the top of the brackets the windshield will not be able to be folded down. If the bracket or any accessory is mounted on the side there is a possibility that the windshield may not be able to be folded down. Bracket is not intended for a Light Bar.

Repeat Steps 1-6 on Passenger side Using bracket B instead of A.
