
Review the instruction pages in their entirety to prepare the required tools

Warning: Please check for wiring or other obstructions before drilling any holes in the vehicle. If it is necessary to drill any holes, Dee Zee recommends putting a sealant or rust inhibitory around all holes drilled into the body of the vehicle.

It is the sole responsibility of the vehicle owner to check for tire clearance. It is unlawful and dangerous to ride on any external vehicle step while the vehicle is in motion.


Cleaning: To be entitled to all warranty rights offered with the product, Dee Zee steps need to be cleaned regularly with a mild detergent. Do NOT use abrasive cleaners. For stainless steel products, the application of a high grade automotive wax is recommended.





Measure from the top of the driver bracket (A) 6 inches down and use an alcohol pad (J) to clean off the next 6 inches of the inside surface of the bracket on each side. Then peel off one side to the tape and apply it 6 inches down from the top of the bracket as shown. Repeat on passenger bracket (B) using the same alcohol pad.




Peel up one corner of the double sided tape to the outside of the bracket. Then use alcohol pad (J) to clean off the A-pillar on the jeep in the area shown in the picture below. Repeat this step with the passenger bracket and the passenger side A-pillar.






Set driver bracket on the previous installed cowl bracket to see what slots will be used. Install bolts (F), and nuts (I) through the slots of the driver side bracket cowl bracket and the driver A-pillar bracket. Make sure the backing of the double sided tape is showing before tightening the bolts.




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Remove the backing of the tape and push the bracket against the vehicle.




Mounting the accessory mount bracket (C) is optional. If you want to mount the accessory mount bracket install bolt (G) through the bracket and put a nut (H) on the back side and slide the bracket in the channel and locate the desired position. Fully tighten bracket.



When A-Pillar bracket is mounted the windshield will <u>not</u> be able to be folded down.
Brackets C and D are not intended for a Light Bar.

Install bolt (G) though the endcap (E) and install nut (H) on the other side. Slide nut into channel until the endcap is flush with the top of the bracket and <u>fully tighten hardware.</u>



Repeat Steps 4-7 on Passenger side Using bracket B instead of A.
