

### **Ignition Coil Boot Installation**

- 1. Confirm that there is a spring in the new ignition coil boot.
- 2. Add a small amount of dielectric grease to inner wall on both ends of boot.
- Attach the new insulator boot to the ignition coil, by pressing the insulator until it is properly mated with the ignition coil. (See Fig. 1)
- After attaching the insulator boot to the coil, position the ventilation hole of the insulator boot. (See Fig. 2)




