

TECH NOTES: Installation Instructions



NOTE: READ INSTRUCTIONS THOROUGHLY BEFORE INSTALLATION WORK BEGINS

Thank you for purchasing a new **DORMAN** power steering pulley! Please take note of the following installation notes to ensure proper installation.

- This pulley is a press fit pulley. Special tools and installation techniques are required to properly install this
 pulley. Failure to use the appropriate tools and procedures may result in damage to the pulley and/or
 power steering pump or an inability to fully install the new pulley on the pump shaft.
- The small bolt/nut/washer kit included with many remanufactured power steering pumps is often
 inadequate to install a new pulley due to the tight press fit of new parts. In this case, a quality power
 steering installation tool will be required.
- The outside diameter of the new pulley may be slightly different than the pulley you are replacing. This will
 not affect the operation of the pulley or power steering pump; however
 some applications may require a slightly longer belt.
