Tools required for removal and installation of console lid:

- Plastic pry tool (Dorman FG# 49051) or flat-blade screwdriver
- Phillips screwdriver or power screwdriver with Phillips attachment



Removal Instructions

STEP 1: Lift the console lid to the up position.



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STEP 2: Using a Phillips screwdriver or power screwdriver with Phillips attachment, remove the eight (8) screws on the underside of the console lid.



STEP 3: Using a plastic pry tool or flat-blade screwdriver, pry the underside of the console lid from the console.



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STEP 4: Press the latch through the hole to remove the underside of the console lid from the console.



STEP 5: Using a Phillips screwdriver or power screwdriver with Phillips attachment, remove the four (4) screws to disconnect the top of the console lid from the center console.



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Installation Instructions

STEP 1: Using a Phillips screwdriver or power screwdriver with Phillips attachment, attach the four (4) screws to connect the top of the console lid to the center console.



STEP 2: Press the underside of the console lid onto the console, making sure to feed the latch through the hole at the top.
