General Installation Instructions

When servicing any vehicle be sure to follow all safety procedures. First, make sure that when lifting the vehicle that you use an appropriate jack with a proper weight rating. Before going underneath any vehicle, make sure that it is properly supported with sturdy jack stands and on level ground so that the vehicle doesn't fall or slide off of the jack and onto you. As with any automotive repair, make sure you have the appropriate tools to do the job so you don't damage any parts on the vehicle. Safety glasses and mechanic's gloves should also be worn for your protection.

Take care not to exceed the Gross Vehicle Weight Rating (GVWR), or the maximum load recommended by the manufacturer. It is important that all the vehicle owner manuals recommendations are followed for your own safety and to prevent damage to the vehicle.

Once you are ready to disable the ride light, you will need to disconnect the negative battery cable (-) to prevent electrical shock/malfunction.

Even though every attempt is made to ensure this information is complete and accurate, it is impossible to account for all possible circumstances or situations. 1. Lift vehicle and remove wheels.

7.	Have another person hold the strut assembly while you remove the last remaining bolt. Carefully remove the strut assembly from the vehicle.	Contraction of the second seco
8.	Using a 12 point torque bit, remove the 6 upper shock mounting bolts. Remove the top cast aluminum shock cap.	

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Insta	allation Instructions	
1.	With the upper cast piece and the new coil strut, align the forked bottom of the shock centered on the center mounting point of the upper mount. Note: If the assembly is slightly misaligned, this can be adjusted later during installation.	
2.	Lift the strut back into position and aligning the pin at the front right of the center mounting hole. Install upper 3 bolts to hold the strut then tighten.	
3.	Center the fork onto the lower control arm bushing. Install the factory mounting bolt then tighten.	
4.	Reinstall the ball joints back into the knuckle assembly an	d affix with the factory hardware

previously removed. A pair of pliers can help in seating the ball joints.

Re	Removal Instructions		
1.	1. Start by removing the remaining air pressure from the rear air spring. To deflate the air spring, carefully remove the air fitting from the bottom.		
2.	Loosen and remove the upper mounting plate's bolts.		
3.	Remove the lower shock bolt connecting the shock to the lower control arm.		
4.	With the shock loose, collapse the shock absorber by push the upper mount to be dislocated from its mounting perch		
5.	With the upper mount dislodged, pull the air shock assembly up and out of the lower control arm.		
6.	With the aid of a large pair of pliers, compress the parking brake lever and remove the cable.		

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
7.	Remove the parking brake cable retaining clip, and slide the cable out of its mount. Set aside. This is reused later.	
8.	Remove the bolt securing the wheel speed sensor on the front side of the wheel hub. Let the sensor hang.	
9.	Locate the height sensor bracket on the back left of the lower control arm. Remove its mounting nut from the inside of the control arm to free the height sensor.	
10.	Next loosen, but DO NOT REMOVE, the lower control arm's rearmost bolts. This will eliminate binding during installation.	
11.	Using a paint pen or permanent marker, mark the eccentric bolt alignment at the knuckle and remove it, being sure to turn the nut on the backside. The control arm will now hang free.	

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Installation Instructions

1. Install the rear shock up from the bottom, making sure the locating pins are facing outward. Install the two factory upper mounting bolts and tighten.



- 2. Swing the control arm up to align the shock bushing to its mounting hole. Spacers are provided for the shock bushing. One is used per side. Secure with the factory hardware.
- 3. Using a floor jack, lift directly under the shock mount until the knuckle bolt is aligned.

CAUTION! Do not to lift the car off the jack stands!

4. Align the marks previously made on the eccentric bolt and tighten. Go back and tighten the rearmost bolts of the lower control arm.

5. Finish by re-installing the wheel speed sensor, parking brake cable, and height sensor.

Note: The air hose can be tied off or doubled back into the open clips already installed.

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Audi Allroad Quattro 2000 – 2005 Electronic Air Suspension Disarming

2003-2005 Model years may experience a 'Check Engine' light due to the integration of the air suspension system into the "Data-Bus" system. If preferred, the computer can be left active for emission purposes but the compressor should still be unplugged.

To deactivate the air suspension system, unplug the air suspension computer module located on the left side of the cargo area. After the computer is unplugged, there will be no functioning part of the air suspension system, including the dash-mounted control panel or warning lights. Please read instruction completely before beginning.

2. Remove the screw holding on the cargo hook on the lower left of the side panel.		
3. Remove the screw located near the pillar in the back on the cargo cover's anchor point.
