Matte Body Wash

Add 2 full caps of Matte Body Wash to a bucket (with Grit Guard) and fill with water. From there the soap will foam up, giving you a cushion for to avoid abrasion. Starting from the top of the car, agitate with a clean wash pad until you reach the bottom. Flip and rinse the wash pad often to prevent trapped contaminants from marring the surface. After completing your wash, rinse and dry with a microfiber towel.

Matte Paint Coating

Ensure your surface is fully clean and wet before you apply Matte Paint Coating to ensure proper bonding. We recommend using Matte Paint Cleanser to spot clean any stubborn or embedded contaminants, followed by a quick rinse. Apply a small portion to your applicator and wipe onto a panel, taking care to achieve full coverage. After coating a panel, wipe down immediately and move to next panel until entire car is coated.

Matte Paint Cleanser

Spray onto surface area containing the contaminant you want to remove. Wait a few minutes, then wipe down to remove contaminant. If contaminant is still present, repeat application until eliminated.

Matte Final Finish

Spray onto a lightly soiled area then immediately wipe clean with a microfiber towel.
