- 2. DISCONNECT RUBBER EXHAUST HANGERS FROM EXHAUST HANGER BRACKETS, THREE EACH SIDE (ONE FORWARD AND TWO REARWARD OF MUFFLER).
- 3. REMOVE REARMOST EXHAUST HANGER BRACKETS, ONE EACH SIDE, BY REMOVING (3) NUTS, WHICH SECURE HANGER BRACKETS TO STUDS IN VEHICLE BULKHEAD, AND UNFASTENING RETAINING CLIPS, ONE EACH SIDE.

 NOTE: EXHAUST HANGER BRACKETS WILL BE REINSTALLED IN STEP 6.
- 4. CAREFULLY CUT OFF LOWER STUD, EACH SIDE, AS CLOSE TO BULKHEAD AS POSSIBLE (SEE FIGURE 2). DO NOT CUT OFF TWO (2) UPPER STUDS.




FIGURE 3 MODIFICATION OF HEAT SHIELDS DRIVER'S SIDE HEAT SHIELD SHOWN. MODIFICATION TYPICAL BOTH SIDES NOTE: DO NOT REMOVE HEAT SHIELDS FROM VEHICLE TO MODIFY.

- 5. MODIFY HEAT SHIELDS AS SHOWN IN FIGURE 3.
- NOTE: DO NOT REMOVE PUSH—IN FASTENERS WHICH ATTACH HEAT SHIELDS TO VEHICLE. ONCE PUSH—IN FASTENERS ARE REMOVED, THEY CANNOT BE RE—USED.
- 6. RE-INSTALL EXHAUST HANGER BRACKETS, USING (2) OF THE (3) NUTS REMOVED IN STEP 3, ON (2) UPPER STUDS (SEE FIG. 2). HANGER BRACKET MUST BE ORIENTED SO THAT SQUARE HOLE IN BRACKET ALIGNS WITH RETAINING CLIP IN VEHICLE BULKHEAD.
- 7. RAISE HITCH INTO POSITION AS SHOWN IN FIGURE 1.
- NOTE: ON VEHICLES EQUIPPED WITH AIR PUMP MOUNTED ON PASSENGER'S SIDE FRAME RAIL, TEMPORARILY REMOVE PUMP BY REMOVING TWO (2) BOLTS WHICH SECURE PUMP TO FRAME. RETAIN FASTENERS FOR REINSTALLATION OF PUMP AFTER HITCH IS INSTALLED.
- 8. INSTALL M12 BOLTS AND 1/2" CONICAL TOOTHED WASHERS AS SHOWN IN FIGURE 1.
- 9. REINSTALL AIR PUMP USING EXISTING BOLTS AS SHOWN IN FIG. 1. BE SURE TO PLACE 1/4" BLOCK BETWEEN PUMP AND FRAME RAIL AT FORWARD ATTACHMENT AS SHOWN.
- 10. RE-CONNECT RUBBER EXHAUST HANGERS (THREE EACH SIDE).
- 11. RAISE SPARE TIRE.



EXHAUST HANGER BRACKET
