






- 1. Remove six (6) bumper bolts, bumper and (2) shim plates if present.
- 2. Remove OEM tow hooks if present.
- 3. Place bumper on protected surface to prevent scratching. Place receiver inside bumper. See Figure 2.
- 4. Loosen six (6) nuts to remove lower front cross member (if equipped).
- 5. Center receiver hole pattern side to side on bumper hole pattern. Mark location of drilled holes in bumper, in center of receiver slots. See Figure 3.
- 6. Remove receiver from bumper and drill marked holes with 5/8" drill.
- 7. Place receiver on frame.
- 8. Reinstall lower front cross member (if equipped).
- 9. Reinstall OEM tow hooks removed in Step 2.
- 10. Reinstall bumper using four (4) fasteners removed in Step 1. Do not install shim plates.
- 11. Install remaining fasteners as shown in Figure 1. CAUTION: HOLD DRIVER'S SIDE HANDLE NUTS IN PLACE TO PREVENT THEM FROM ROTATING INTO AIR CONDITIONG CONDENSER.
- 12. Return shim plates to customer.

Cequent

Tighten all fasteners with torque wrench to 50 Lb.-Ft (68 N-m).
