- 3. Once tow hook is loosened, slide hitch in-between the frame and the tow hook and reinstall the tow hooks with hitch in place.
- 4. With front hitch mounts secured use rear holes as a guide to drill a 1/2" hole into the frame.
- 5. Use 1/2" bolt leaders to pull 1/2" carriage bolts and spacer blocks thru the existing holes and through the hitch as shown. Square shoulders of bolts must be pulled into blocks to engage with the sides of frame. Install conical washers and hex nuts as shown.
- Torque all hardware to the specs specified below.

Tighten all 12mm fasteners with torque wrench to 90 Lb.-Ft. Tighten all 1/2" fasteners with torque wrench to 75 Lb.-Ft.
