Wipe away any residue and allow to completely dry.



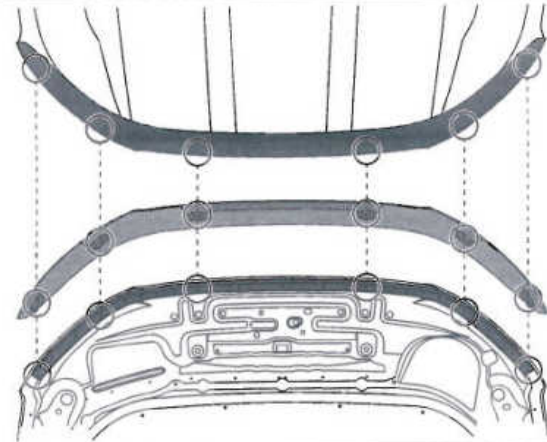
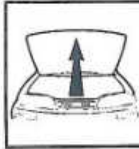

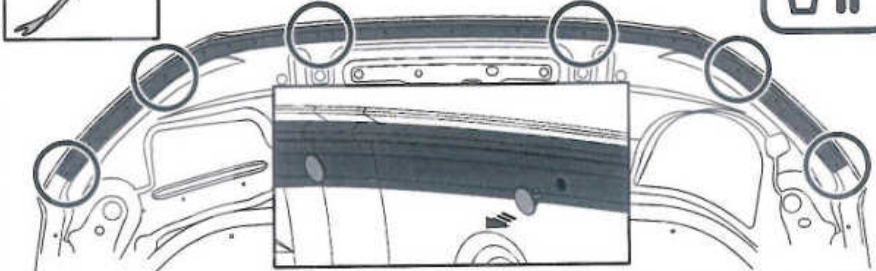
Trial fit the Hood Deflector centrally onto the hood, align the front edge of the Hood Deflector with the hood lip.

Note where the six slots on the tags correspond to the scrivenets on the underside of the hood.



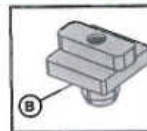
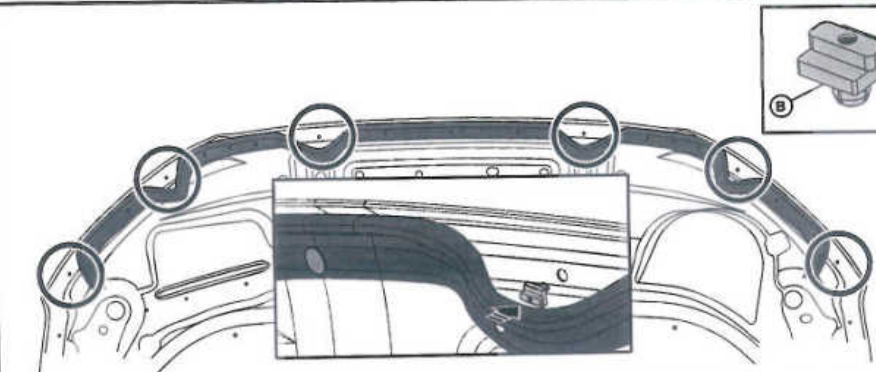

At the previously noted scrivenet locations carefully remove the scrivenets attaching the hood seal and discard.







Gently peel back the rubber seal and insert a screw plug into the vacant holes in the underside of the hood.
