#### IV. Vehicle Preparation

- 1. Disconnect the wiring harness from both fog lights.
- **2.** Open the Hood and remove the 8 dart clips holding the plastic radiator valance. See Image Below:




Figure 1 - CLIP REMOVAL

**3.** Remove the grill. Remove the four 10mm bolts on the upper surface located under the radiator shroud. Gently pull the left side of the grill forward while pinching the 6 body clips with a pair of needle nose pliers from left to right.

**4.** Remove bolts and swing outer bumper support tubes down and out of the way, using a 15mm socket. Two Bolts per side. See Image Below:




Figure 2 – Outer Bumper Support Screws

- **5.** Remove the dart clips holding the rubber valance between the frame and the bumper. Also remove the two darts clips attaching the rubber valance to the grill.
- **6.** Remove 21mm nuts (2 Per Side) from the bolt strips holding the bumper brackets to the frame. NOTE: SUPPORT BUMPER BEFORE REMOVING BOLT STRIPS! See Image Below:

- **7.** With the bumper supported remove the bolts strip holding the bumper to the frame.
- **8.** Pull outward slightly at the fender wells and remove the bumper from the front.
- **9.** With Bumper removed from the truck, remove the 18mm bolts attaching the Factory Tow Hooks to the frame. Remove the tow hooks. See Image Below

**10.** Remove the two plastic brackets at the front of each fender by removing the two dart clips from the wheel well and the three 10mm bolts. See Image Below

- **11.** Remove the driver headlight by removing two 10mm bolts from the top, one 10mm bolt from the front, and one 10mm bolt from the side. Repeat for passenger side
- **12.** With Headlights removed from the vehicle, remove the brackets off of the bottom of each by removing the 2 Torx screws. See Image Below:

**13.** On the passenger side remove the wheel well liner front support. By first removing the bolts from the front half of the wheel well liner. Then remove one Christmas tree clip and one small bolt behind the wheel well.



**14.** Your Truck is now ready for the installation of your New FAB FOURS BUMPER!

#### V. <u>Bumper Installation</u>

- 1. Carefully, with the help of a friend, place the bumper up to the truck and align the frame holes with the inner mounting brackets of the bumper.
- 2. Replace the stock bolt strips and nuts but do not tighten. For ease of installation, insert each bolt strip from the outside of the truck with the nuts on the inside of the frame, as shown below.


- 3. Align the bumper to the truck leaving at least 1/8" gaps beneath the headlights and grill.
- 4. Tighten mounting bolts.
- 5. Trim wheel well liner to match. This will need to be done carefully to make sure to cover the painted surfaces behind the bumper.
- 6. Enjoy your new bumper from Fab Fours!
